Systems Leadership in Practice

This series of workshops explores in greater depth the practice of systems leadership in the public sector. Individuals will have the opportunity to develop systems leadership skills and behaviours by working through an existing “wicked” problem over the three workshops.

Delegates will:

- Review the principles of systems thinking and conceptual models.
- Learn how to think and act like an effective systems leader.
- Develop skills and behaviours for relationship building, influencing and collaboration.
- Understand how systems leaders manage tensions and enable emergent ideas.
- Reflect on personal tolerance for the ambiguity and uncertainty of complex systems.
